Introducing MCDL's New Bookmobile!

The Bookmobile has many of the capabilities of a physical library. Patrons can apply for a library card, place holds, and browse the collection. The vehicle is a Wi-Fi hotspot.



The new Bookmobile is designed with the needs of the youngest and most senior patrons in mind. It features a lift and specialty book carts that can be rolled inside senior facilities. These carts lock in place and serve as additional browsing for patrons who board the bus at public stops.



Bookmobile History

- 1948 The Bookmobile debuted at the County Fair. It began serving outlying areas and schools in Brunswick, Lodi, and Liverpool.
- 1950 The Bookmobile started making stops in Seville.
 - 1958 A second Bookmobile
 was acquired. One had
 adult materials for community
 stops and the other carried
 materials for schools.
- 1962 The 1948 Bookmobile was replaced.
- 1966 The 1958 Bookmobile was retired.
 - 1982 Bookmobile service was suspended when the library became a county library, not a school system library.
- 1991 A new 28-foot Bluebird bus took to the roads.
- 2005 After 14 years a new Bookmobile debuts, retiring the 1991 model.
- 2021 MCDL debuts a new Bookmobile in August.


