## Holiday Head Start: Embroidered Kitchen Towel

### **Supplies Needed:**

- Towel
- Embroidery Thread
- Stabilizer
  - o Tear-A-Way
  - o Wash-A-Way
  - Sticky
- Design
  - II Fonts and Dozens of Designs on Machine
  - o For more designs, search online and bring a PES file on Flash Drive

## **Supplies Provided:**

- Embroidery Machine
- Hoops (4 sizes)
- Bobbin Thread (White or Black)
- Needles, Clips, and Other Sewing Tools

## **Step by Step Instructions:**

#### **Watch Training Video**

First time users will need to watch a training video, approximately 40 minutes in length.

#### **Choose Pattern and Create Image**

- Step I- Choose Design (provided on machine).
- Step 2- Add Text (fonts on machine).
- Step 3- Make sure image/text is correct size for the towel.

#### **Prepare Material for Machine**

- Step I- Place stabilizer in correct size hoop.
- Step 2- Find center of towel.

- Step 3- Place towel over stabilizer in hoop.
- Step 4- Put top part of hoop over towel.
- Step 5- Tighten hoop.
- Step 6- Make sure material is taut.
- Step 7- Place hoop into machine.

#### **Thread Machine**

- Step I- View pattern screen for correct color to start with.
- Step 2- Keep thread taught.
- Step 3- Follow the numbers and arrows.
- Step 4- Use automatic needle threader.

#### **Embroider Towel**

- Step I- Put presser foot down.
- Step 2- Press Start.
- Step 3- Repeat instructions for "Threading Machine" and "Embroider Towel" until pattern is complete.
- Step 4- Remove hoop.
- Step 5- Remove Towel.

#### Remove Stabilizer

- Step I- Trim excess stabilizer around pattern.
- Step 2- If Wash-a-way stabilizer, wash towel.
- Step 3- If not Wash-a-way stabilizer, carefully tear/trim the stabilizer off the towel.
