The Medina County Art League (MCAL) is offering scholarships again this year to graduating high school seniors who are continuing their art education in college (majoring or minoring in an art field).

This year we have set aside \$2600 for scholarship awards. (There may be additional awards.)

The amounts are as follows: First Place-\$1000

Third Place-\$550

Second Place-\$700

Honorable Mention-\$350

The requirements for competing are:

- 1) Portfolio—five pieces maximum
  - a. Two dimensional artwork, matted and backed (maximum size is 48" in any direction).
  - b. Three dimensional artwork (maximum size is 22"x22"x28")
- 2) Completed MCAL Scholarship Application
- 3) Copy of college acceptance letter

**All of these items MUST be present at take-in or the student will be disqualified.**

There will be no reception this year due to COVID-19. Results will be posted on the MCAL website and Facebook page. The Medina Library will also be posting the results on their Facebook page. All winners will be notified by email and scholarship awards will be mailed to the recipients. The show will be open to the public on the third floor of the Medina Library and will be on display from March 10—31.

## 2021 Continuing Art Education Scholarship Awards

**1st place-\$1000 2nd place-\$700 3rd place-\$550 HM-\$350**

**Eligibility:** Medina County high school graduating seniors who are continuing their art education in college (as a major or minor) following graduation.

- Requirements:**
1. Portfolio containing a maximum of **five pieces** of original matted and backed artwork (no frames, unless stretched canvas) no larger than 48" in any direction. 3D artwork (no larger than 22"x22"x28") may be included in the total of five pieces of artwork. Work may be from class projects.
  2. Copy of your **college acceptance letter**.
  3. Completed Medina County **Art League application**.
  4. **List of works**.

**Where & When:** Portfolios should be delivered to the Medina County Public Library **March 1-3**.

**Please Note:** **Be sure that all items listed above are in your portfolio!** You could be *disqualified* if the portfolio does not contain the items above.

**Notification:** Winners will be notified by email by **March 8th**. The decisions of the judges are final.

**Awards:** The Medina County Art League will not be hosting a reception due to COVID-19 but photos and announcements will be available on the Medina County Art League website and on their Facebook Page. The Medina Library will also be listing winners on the Library Facebook Page. Scholarship winners will receive their awards by mail.

**Liability:** Neither the Medina County Art League nor the Medina Public Library accept liability for damage or loss to any artwork regardless of reason.

**Exhibit Dates:** **March 10-31 in the Medina Library's B.Smith Gallery.**




## Additional Scholarship Opportunity






