- Create your project and save it as a PDF, EPS, JPG, or TIFF file. If you would like your file to be enlarged, create your file as a high-resolution image.
- Email the Family History & Learning Center staff at makerspace@mcdl.info with...
 - Your file (either as an attachment or a Dropbox, One Drive, or Google Drive link)
 - Your choice of media (see options below)
 - The print output dimensions (maximum width is 50")
- When we receive your print job, you will be invoiced through PayPal. Material fees are \$3.00 per linear foot, rounded to the nearest quarter.
- After receiving your payment, we will print your job.
- When your project is complete, we will e-mail you for pickup.
- Plan accordingly! Print jobs are processed in the order received/paid. Turnaround time is generally 1 to 2 weeks.

Available Media Options:

- **Light Weight Banner Vinyl** - Ideal for indoor and outdoor applications. Durable, tear-resistant, and edges won't curl. Specs: 13 oz. coated scrim banner with 1000 denier.
- **Clear Vinyl with Permanent Adhesive** - Excellent print quality/clarity make it a useful inkjet vinyl for a variety of graphic applications that require extended indoor or outdoor life. Durable and water-resistant. Specs: 3 mil pressure-sensitive calendared vinyl.
- **Matte Vinyl with Permanent Adhesive** - Excellent white point along with a low gloss level make it a useful inkjet vinyl for a variety of graphic applications that require extended indoor or outdoor life. Durable and water-resistant. Specs: 4 mil pressure-sensitive calendared vinyl with a matte finish.
- **Premium Matte Paper** - Intended for high-resolution, full-color printing and features excellent opacity and white point characteristics. Specs: 8 mil, matte, 190 gsm constructed paper.
